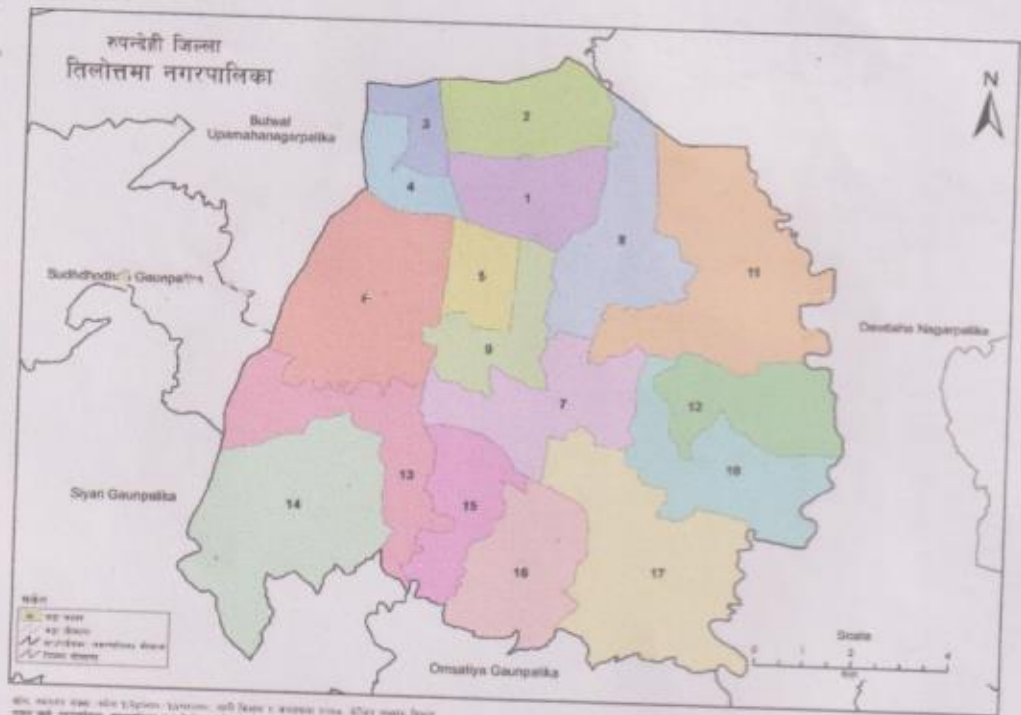



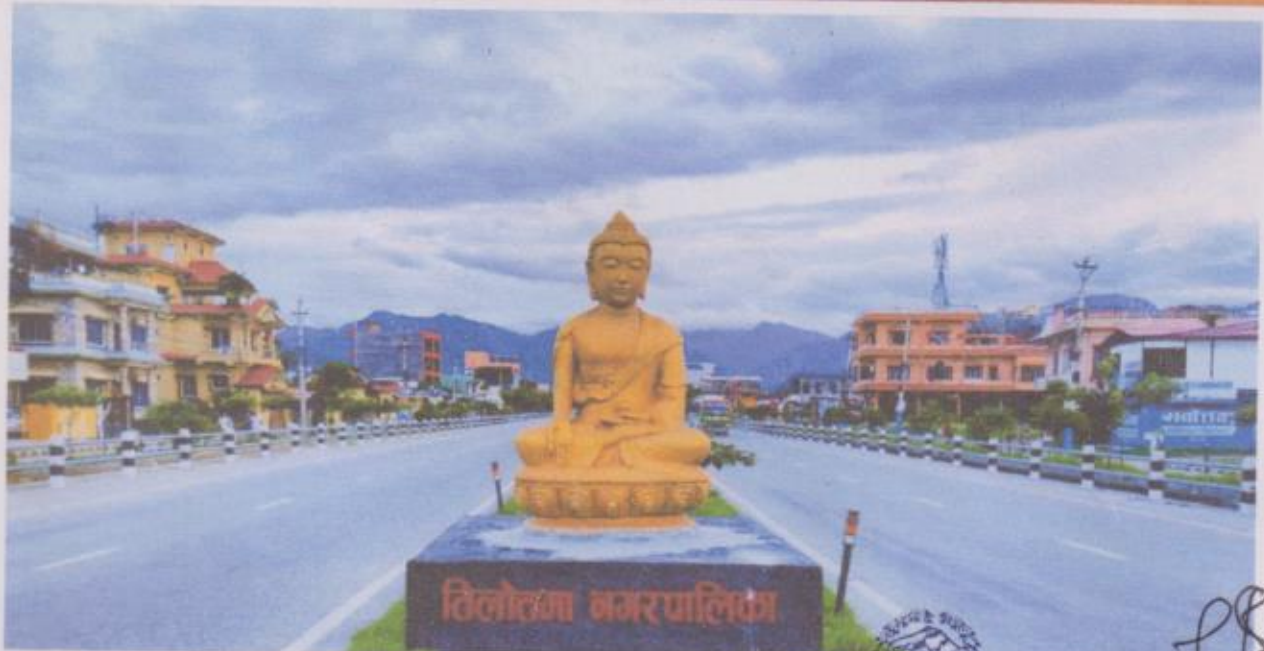
## 2. INTRODUCTION

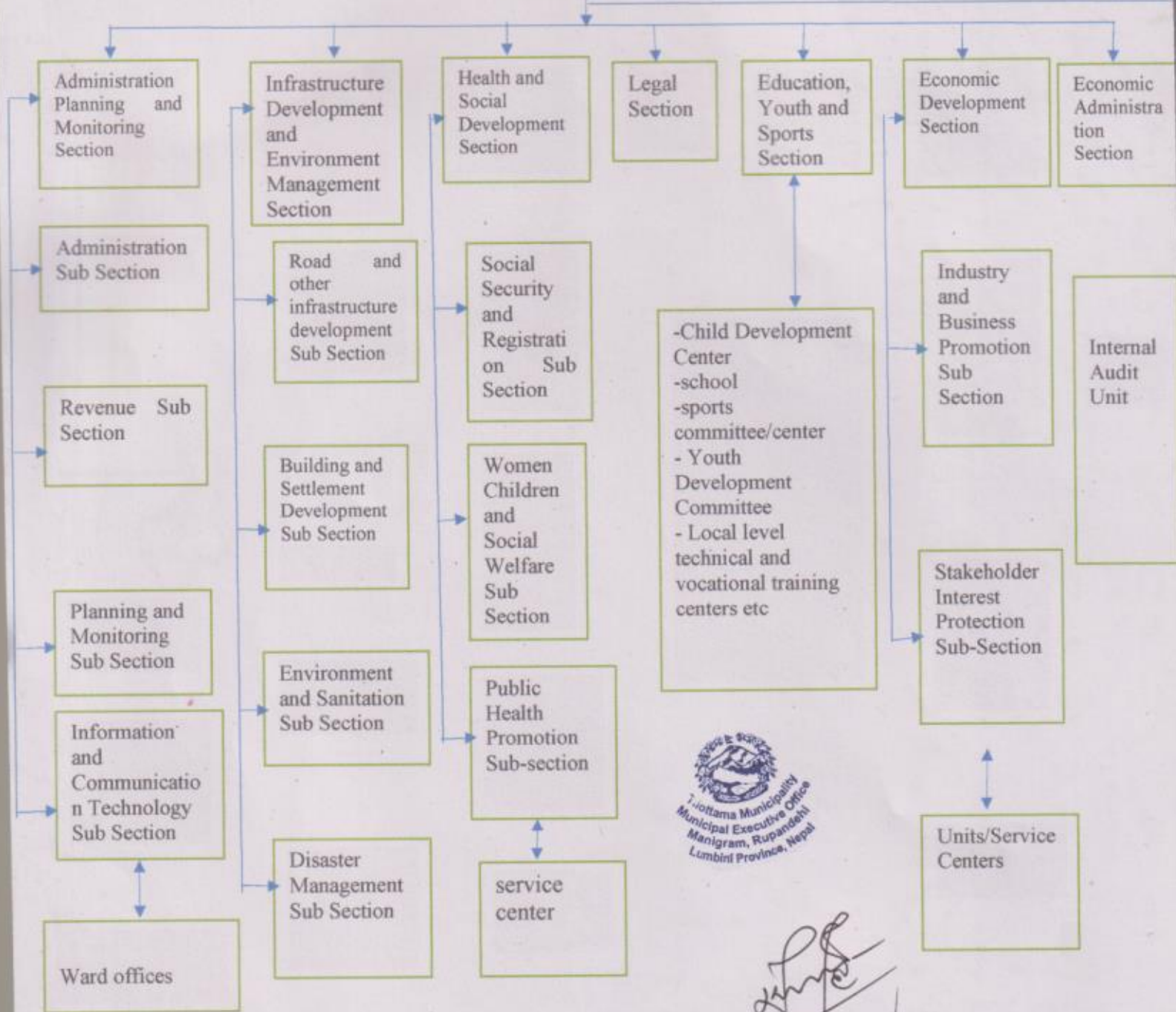
